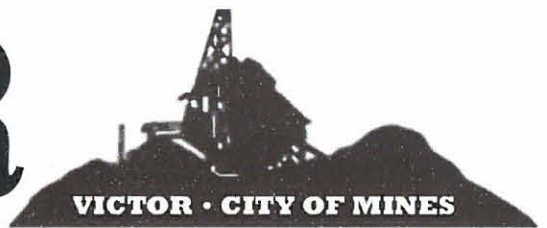

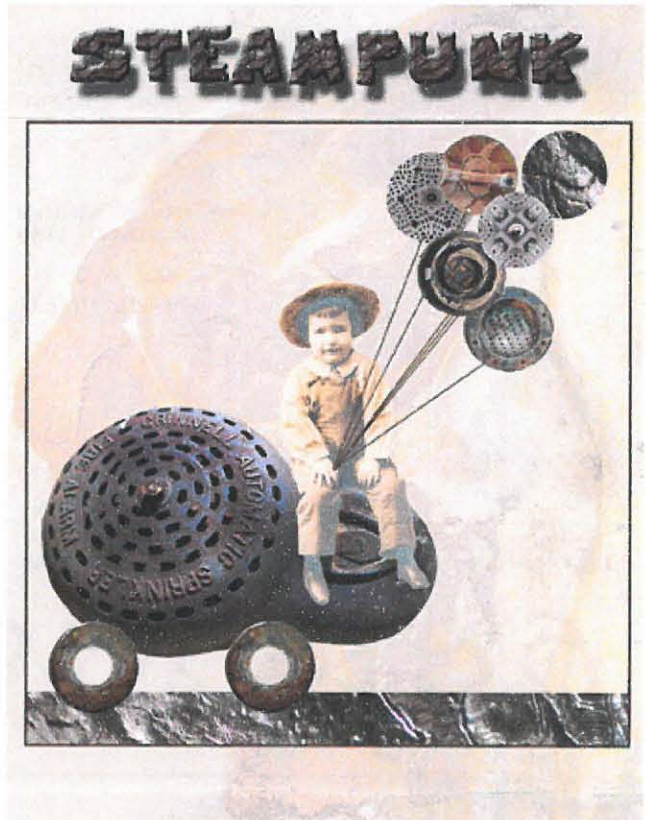

NEWS from Councilor Michael Wallace 689-2784

PUBLIC WORKS: This past month, thirty-one folks called the Public Works Department to report that they were visited by Jack Frost. Two had frozen sewer lines and twenty-nine had frozen water lines. Some reported that this is the first time the problem occurred. City Ordinances mandate that problems with water lines between the building and the water meter and sewer lines between the property line and the building are the responsibility of the property owner. In the past, the City crew used a device called a thaw box to help on the home side of frozen lines; however, this device may cause plumbing damage. After the City insurance company received claims for damages they informed us they would no longer pay these claims. As much as we would like to help, we must cater to reducing and eliminating the risk of liability. What the City will do is to help to determine if the problem is on the responsibility of the City or property owner. If you have continuing freezing problems, you should contact your plumber for advice on reducing your risk if freezing. For tips to avoid frozen pipes published by the American Red Cross, visit our website at victorcolorado.com or pick up a copy at City Hall. First day of Spring is March 20th.

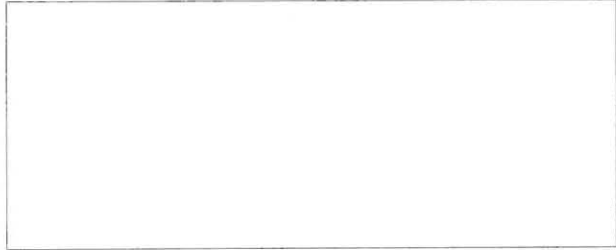
